Standard Specification for Consumer Product Safety for Children's Toys

Since 1986, ASTM International's Standard Consumer Safety Specification for Toy Safety (F963) has widely been considered the "gold standard" for toy safety. It is continually reviewed by ASTM International members to keep pace with innovation and new information and to ensure consistent application.

Since 2009, all toys in the United States must meet the safety requirements of F963, per the Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act of 2008 (CPSIA), which makes it a mandatory federal standard.

ASTM International's committee on consumer products (Committee F15) regularly reviews and updates the standard as needed to ensure that its technical guidance is up to date and incorporates emerging hazards. This committee is comprised of a dedicated group representing industry, government, consumers, academia, and other interested parties.

F963 includes requirements and test methods to prevent potential injuries such as choking, sharp edges, toxins, pinching, and other potential hazards.
