Lead in paint and similar surface coatings in children's products

Federal regulations, The Consumer Product Safety Commission in 16 CFR part 1303 came into force in 2008. Based on this law all children's products, and some furniture, for adult and children, must not contain a concentration of lead greater than 0.009 percent (90 parts per million) in paint or any similar surface coatings.
